

TheAccountant.XYZ - macOS Installation Guide

Which File to Download?


 **For Apple Silicon Macs (M1, M2, M3 chips):**

Download: **TheAccountant.XYZ_1.0.0_aarch64.dmg**

 **For Intel Macs:**

Download: **TheAccountant.XYZ_1.0.0_universal.dmg**

 **Not sure which Mac you have?**

- Click the **Apple logo** () in top-left corner
 - Select **About This Mac**
 - Look for "Chip" or "Processor"
 - If it says **Apple M1/M2/M3** → Download the **aarch64** version
 - If it says **Intel** → Download the **universal** version
 - When in doubt → Download the **universal** version (works on all Macs)

How to Install

Step 1: Open the DMG file

1. **Double-click** the downloaded .dmg file
2. A window will open showing the app

Step 2: Install the App

1. **Drag** the TheAccountant.XYZ app to the **Applications** folder
2. Wait for the copy to complete
3. **Eject** the DMG (click the eject button in Finder sidebar)


Step 3: First Time Opening

Since this app is not from the Mac App Store, macOS will show a security warning. **This is normal!**

You'll see this message:

"TheAccountant.XYZ" can't be opened because it is from an unidentified developer

Here's how to open it:

1. Click **"Cancel"** (Don't click "Move to Trash"!)
2. Open **Finder** → **Applications**
3. Find **TheAccountant.XYZ**
4. **Right-click** (or Control+click) on the app
5. Select **Open** from the menu
6. A new dialog appears → Click **Open**
7.  The app launches!

Note: You only need to do this once. Next time, just double-click to open.

Alternative Method (If Right-Click Doesn't Work)

1. Try to open the app (it will be blocked)
2. Open **System Settings** (or System Preferences on older macOS)
3. Go to **Privacy & Security**
4. Look for: "TheAccountant.XYZ was blocked from use"
5. Click **Open Anyway**
6. Enter your Mac password
7. Click **Open** in the final dialog
